Sever Ties with India and US to establish Peace in the Region:

Has not Enough Muslim Blood Been Spilled Already for us to Finally Re-Establish the Shield of the Muslims, the Khilafah (Caliphate) on the Method of the Prophethood?

Today, Sunday 15 July 2018, has been declared a day of national mourning after the huge blast in Mastung on 13 July that martyred over one hundred thirty Muslims so far, and injured over two hundred. On this day, let us make Dua sincerely that Allah (swt) grants Jannah to those who have died, descend consolation upon the bereaved and bestows cure for the injured. And on this day of reflection, let us commit solemnly to the sure path that will ensure peace and stability for the Muslims, here and elsewhere, the path of Islam and its shield for the Muslims, the Khilafah (Caliphate) on the Method of the Prophethood.

Certainly the claim of General Bajwa during his visit to the bereaved and injured of Mastung, that "our journey to peace hasn't yet reached the desired destination of complete peace but we are successfully nearing its achievement" is a false and hollow claim. It is clear, written in the blood of Muslims on our streets, that Pakistan's leadership is steering Pakistan away from peace for the last seventeen years, ever since the treacherous Musharraf first committed Pakistan to the US War on Terror. It is this despicable war that ensured Pakistan's support of the US such that it established the Raymond Davis network on our soil to spill our blood.
